## **Heart to Spade Conversation**

## Rules:

- Make a line of cluers and a line of guessers.
- Cluers will draw a playing card and also will draw a Joker. The Joker is a card with a well-known word, phrase or name. Don't show the Joker to the guesser.
- All the Jokers are related in some way to playing cards or card games. Think flexibly. Sometimes words have more than one meaning.
- Cluers: Look at the Joker before you show it to the audience. If it's a person or thing you absolutely, positively don't know, you can pass and draw another. Otherwise, show it to the audience.
- In giving your clues, you can only use words beginning with letters in the card you've drawn, NOT INCLUDING "of." In other words, you can only use the letters in the number or face card and the suit. This includes use of words like "and," "the," etc. If the card you've drawn doesn't have the letters that the words start with, you can't use those words. So for example: if you draw the six of clubs, you can use only words starting with the letters S, I, X, C, L, U, B. We'll write your card on the white board so you can see the letters.
- You can use an unlimited number of words beginning with any permissible letter. For instance, if you get the six of clubs, you can have every word in your clue start with the letter X if you want to.
- You can't use any word in your clue that's in the Joker.
- If you use an illegal word, your turn is over. If the Joker hasn't been guessed, give it back. ou can get back in line.
- No physical clues. This isn't charades.
