Equinox 52 Mixer

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1. Get three letters.

2. Think of Scrabble-style words where those letters appear, not necessarily consecutively.

(Acceptable words are determined through discussion with others.

Don't totally make stuff up — you won't need to. If you're stuck, get help. If you're still stuck, trade your cards in.)

Example: you get E, Q, N

$EQN \Rightarrow E\text{QuiNox}$

$ENQ \Rightarrow vEN\text{triloQuist}$

$QEN \Rightarrow QueEN$

$QNE \Rightarrow s\text{QuiNtEd}$

$NEQ \Rightarrow iNE\text{Quality}$

$NQE \Rightarrow uNQ\text{uEnched}$

3.

Enter your three letters into a grid, Scrabble-style (in one horizontal or vertical line), creating one of your words, and/or some new word(s).

(There should be one grid at the end of each table.

Do not change existing grids!)

Example:

FLVR
WGLE
B HDY E
L XWR U
Y CHPG
M Y
B

4. Help others find words and place them in a grid

or

Mill about, collaboratively trying to figure out the words in the grids
(this is a version of the license plate game)

or

Get three letters and start over.
