

If this is the start of the game, choose a new transformation and put this one back.

Pass the paper. The recipient should read the message ONCE, then cover it and write it from memory as accurately as possible.

Replace ONE word with a word that rhymes with it.

Add ONE new word anywhere.

Insert, append, or prepend ONE letter in up to THREE words to make new words. (The letters need not be the same in each word.)

Change a letter in up to THREE words to make new words.

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One at a time, BEFORE passing, WHISPER the message ONCE to the next person, then fold the paper and pass it. The recipient should write down what they heard as accurately as possible.

Replace ONE word with the first word that comes to mind that is associated with it.

Rearrange the words to form a new message. Keep all the major words, and as many minor words as you can.

Replace up to TWO words with synonyms. (You may choose a different sense from the one originally used.)

Replace ONE word with a new word that starts and ends with the same letters as the original.
