

Seven Times Seven

There are 49 cells in the table. Your goal is to write a word (or phrase) in as many cells as possible.

The entries (words or phrases) must strictly adhere to the pattern suggested by the clues.

Scoring: *No more than one entry per cell.*

2 points for each of the entries that are suggested by the clues.

1 point for each other entry, as long as it strictly adheres to the pattern, even if it is in a cell for which a clue is provided.

To get points, entries should have dictionary nature (they should theoretically appear in a large enough dictionary, or in a plausible word list.)

No electronic aids, obviously.
