## **Clues and answers**

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### **The unscrambled clues:**

- ◇ (Combining) Keats' poems with Sousa's music? That's absurd.
- ◇ (Dangerous and) Slippery precursor to April showers.
- ◇ (Impulsive) Late-winter weddings are inauspicious.
- ◇ (Rather) Naive notion: "Politicians heed DC parades."

These need to be written on a large enough paper so everyone can read them.

### **The answers:**

- ◇ Beware the odes of march
- ◇ Beware the ices of March
- ◇ Beware the I do's of March
- ◇ Beware the idea of march

As participants zero in on the final answers, it is probably necessary to hint that each answer differs from a famous warning by a single letter.
