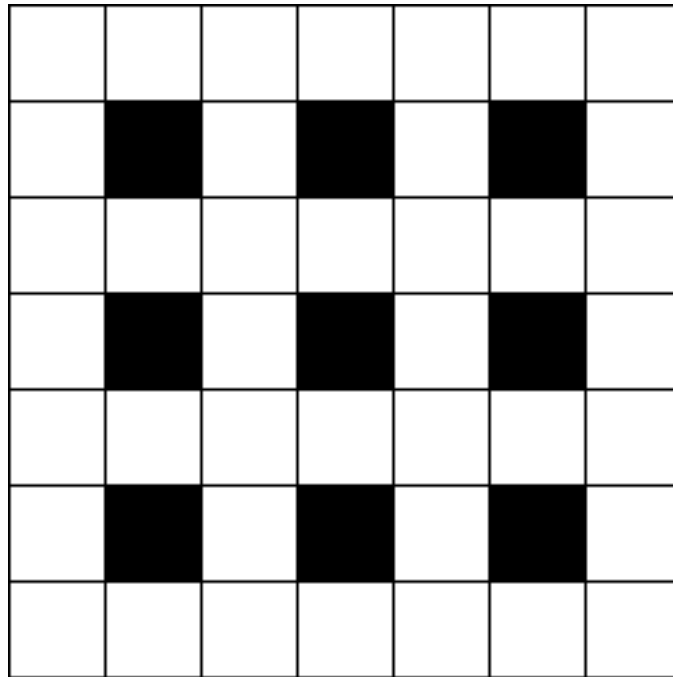


Cross-Purposes Revisited

When the bell rings and it is your turn, call out a letter or “black square”.

All players must *immediately* enter that letter or black square somewhere *in their grid*.

I will give a “five seconds” warning before ringing the bell for the next player.

Once the bell rings, no erasing!

Scoring

The only words that count are Scrabble-type words (single word, no hyphen, no capitals). They should appear in Merriam-Webster’s 11th Collegiate Dictionary.

Words must read in ordinary crossword fashion: across from left to right, or down; starting and ending at the edge of the grid or at a black square.

Words can be of any length from 2 to 7, and are worth as many points as they have letters.
