

DEPARTURES AND ARRIVALS by Qaqaq

In each pair of words below, one letter departs the first word and arrives at the second word; these two letter groups can now be anagrammed to form two words in the same category. For example:

_____ RUBLE __ GENE _____

In this case, “R” departs RUBLE and arrives at GENE; you can then anagram UBLE and GENER to get BLUE and GREEN. Write the anagrams on the long lines closest to the words, and write the moving letter on the line between them. All answers are single words and should be familiar.

Categories are found in alphabetical order at the bottom of the page (unless you really want to go hard-core, in which case just hide them).

When you are done, the central letters will spell one final instruction.
