

Welcome to a puzzle I call **Star Trek: Opposite Episode!**

Kirk and Spock are here and they have sent a message to The Enterprise, and it is your job to decode it. The message is long, so we've broken it up across multiple tables.

On your table is a white envelope. The envelope contains Answer Sheets, Clue Sheets, and another envelope filled with Letter Chips. [SHOW]

You'll fill out the Answer Sheet based on the clues on the Clue Sheet. Then use the answers to fill out The Message at the bottom.

The transparent Letter Chips will help you find the right answer.

Here's an example, the clue sheet might say "[Most expensive] {ad agency}" and the Answer Sheet would look like this.

The answer to that is "priciest publicist" because "most expensive" is "priciest" and an "ad agency" is a type of "publicist".

You use the Letter Chip that says PRIC I to get the first five letters of PRICIEST. Then flip it over to get the middle five letters of PUBLICIST.

The hitch is that each chip can be flipped, rotated, or flipped *and* rotated. Also all the chips are scrambled so you don't know which chip goes where :-P.

There is only one set of Letter Chips per table so you'll have to share!

A very small number of the answers are Star Trek related! If you don't know the answer, maybe someone else at your table does, or you can always try Googling it.

Feel free to collaborate with other tables but note that every table has a slightly different set with a different message, so don't get them mixed them up! When everyone is done, we'll have each table read their Messages in order from 1 through 8 to get the complete message.
