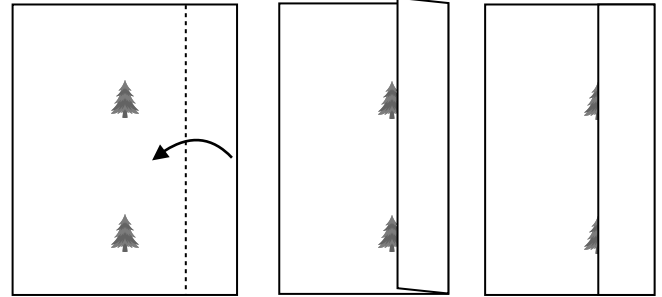


HAPPILY EVER AFTER?

Now that you've explored both sides of these three classic tales, it's time to find out how the stories end – if indeed they have endings at all. Carefully follow the instructions below.

1 Somewhere within or around each puzzle, among the miscellaneous decorations, you will find one unique item which is conspicuously pointing to a specific letter. Circle this letter.

2 Take any puzzle page, and fold the right edge over until it exactly bisects the two fir trees found along the center axis of the page, as illustrated to the right. Crease carefully and leave the page folded.

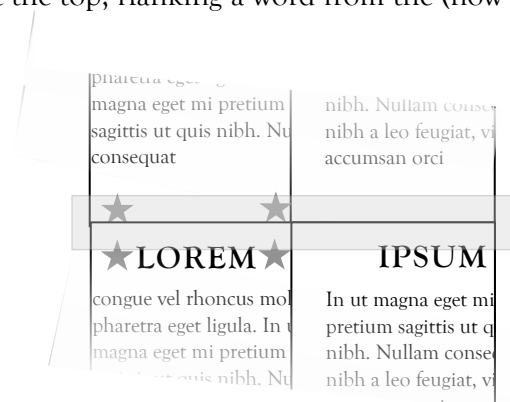


3 Turn the page over and repeat Step 2. The page should now be a strip 1/2 of its original width.

4 Repeat Steps 2 and 3 for the other two pages.

5 Take any strip, and note the two symbols which appear at the top, flanking a word from the (now mostly obscured) puzzle title.

6 Exactly one other strip will have the same pair of symbols near the bottom edge. Place the top of the first strip so that it overlaps the bottom of the second strip by about 1/4", such that all four symbols are still visible, as in the illustration to the right.



7 Carefully tape the two strips together with transparent tape.

8 Turn the combined strip over. Make sure the title word on this side is still visible, and that all the symbols match; then tape this side as well. The two strips should now be securely joined.

9 Repeat steps 5-8 for *all* matching sets of symbols on the top and bottom of every strip.

10 When you've finished connecting all the strips, read all the visible title words from left to right, top to bottom, starting with the word flanked by ? .
